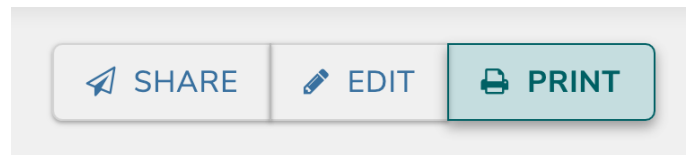


How Can I Print Information in Another Language

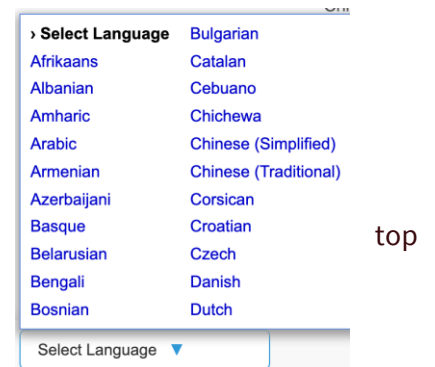
How can I share information with a member in a different language?

Use the “Print” options for Favorites folders to change the language to automatically translate all of the text.

1. Once you’ve made Favorite folders for your most used programs, you can then Print those programs and can optionally print them out in a different language!
Head to your [Favorite folders](#) and select the one you want to print.



2. Once you have selected a folder, you will see the Print option in the top right of the page.
3. Once you are on the Print Preview page, use the “**Select Language**” menu in the bottom left of the page and select one of 100+ languages to translate the listed resources.
4. After you have selected a language, **click the blue print button** at the of the page to print the resources. Note that this button will also appear translated, it should still launch your standard print menu.



Frequently Asked Questions:

How can people living in Florida self-navigate in another language?

The “Select Language” menu is available right below the free text search box on search results pages. It is available in the bottom left of the page on all other pages of the site. The menu also shows up on the mobile site.

Do emails and texts that are sent to seekers get sent in the selected language?

All communication from the platform is sent in English. However, once the member clicks on any links in those communications, they will be brought back to the DCF site. Once they are on the site, they can use the “Select Language” menu to translate the page’s contents.
