

How to Search for Programs

How can you search for programs using <https://staff.myfloridamyfamily.com/?>


By entering a zip code and then using a keyword search or filters, you can find free and reduced cost programs to meet the needs of Florida families.

1. From the homepage, enter a zip code.

Search for **free or reduced cost** services like medical care, food, job training, and more.

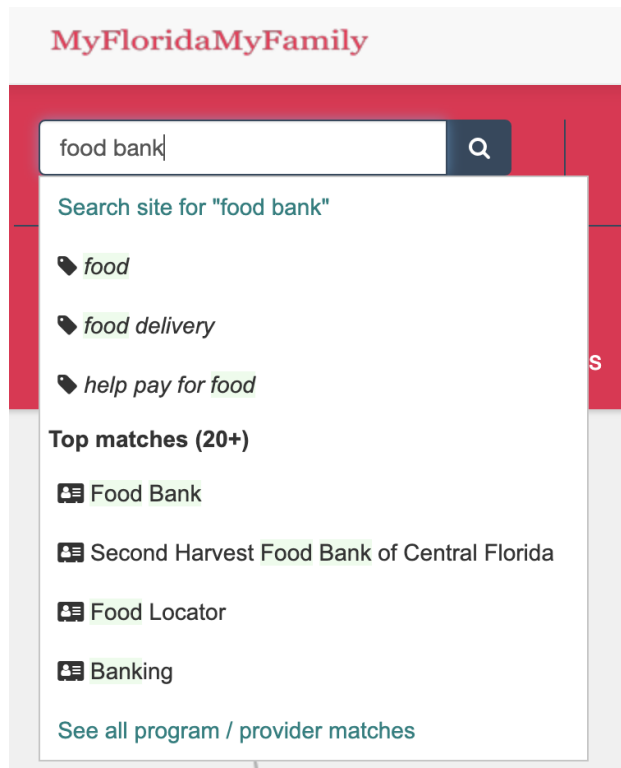

2. Browse for programs by **moving over the navigation bar and drilling down into more specific categories**. The number next to the titles shows the number of programs under that category.

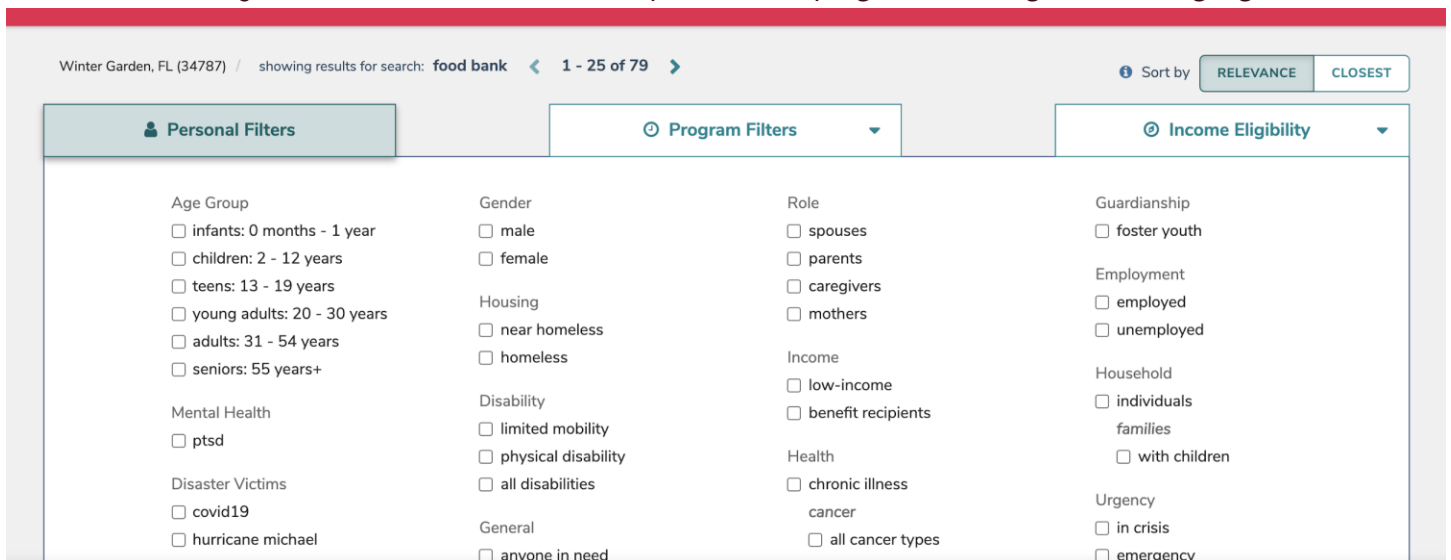

3. You can also **enter a keyword in the search box** to find programs within the patient service area and **click the magnifying glass or press enter** to search.



4. You can further refine search results by **clicking Personal Filters, Program Filters, or Income Eligibility. Click the relevant checkboxes, and then click Filter Search.**
- Personal Filters* show items that are specific to the person you are helping, such as age group or armed forces status.
 - Program Filters* show items that are specific to the program including hours or language.



- By default, your search results will be sorted relevance. **Click Closest** on the upper right side of the results to sort results by distance from the middle of the zip code.
